starsky live scroller projection

Scroller projections are qualified for moving projections on floors, public spaces, landscapes, architecture, large spaces or halls. starsky doesn't work with individual surfaces but with the light room; with the architecture and into the architecture. The projection doesn't illustrate the architecture, it infuses it, overlaps it, distorts it, accentuates it, highlights it, or lets it disappear. Every break of space causes displacements and space-time distortions of the projection; the more pillars, corners, edges, angles, stairways or other breaks are in the area the better. This type of projection is the comprehensive opposite of 3D mapping projection, that applies itself nice and neatly to the architecture, illustrates it, fits in perfectly without opposing it. Starsky developed an interface for analog high performance projectors and adds a timely update to their unsurpassed brilliance and image quality.
